RE: DRAFT ZANZIBAR STANDARDS FOR STAKEHOLDERS' COMMENTS

Zanzibar Bureau of Standards (ZBS) currently has developed **three (3)** draft standards under Spices and Culinary Herbs and is seeking comments from public before being approved by the ZBS Board of Directors and then Gazetted to the Government Gazette. That standards are: -

- i. PCD 699:2025 Dried or dehydrated chilli pepper and paprika**
- ii. PCD 700:2025 Code of hygienic practice for spices and dried aromatic plants**
- iii. PCD 701:2025 Spices and condiments – Determination of acid – insoluble ash**



According to procedures for preparation of Zanzibar Standards the draft standards is hereby circulated for 60 calendar days for stakeholder's comments.

Being one of the key stakeholders in standards development, we kindly request you to go through the draft standards and send your comments regarding its technical contents. Suggestions which entail revision of text should indicate the preferred wording and the relevant clause should be quoted against each comment.
