RE: DRAFT ZANZIBAR NATIONAL STANDARDS FOR STAKEHOLDER'S COMMENTS.

Zanzibar Bureau of Standards (ZBS) currently has developed **four** standards of the Electrical and Electronics technical committee and is seeking comments from public before being approved by the ZBS Board of Directors and then Gazetted to the Government Gazette. The standards are:-

1. **PCD 773:2025 Aluminium PVC insulated conductors for overhead power service lines — Specification**
2. **PCD 774: 2025 Voltages for A.C. transmission and distribution systems — Specification**
3. **PCD 775: 2025 Glossary of Electrotechnical, power, telecommunication, electronics, lighting and colour terms — Part 1: Terms particular power engineering — Group 01: Power cable terminology**
4. **PCD 776-2-24: 2025 Household and similar electrical appliances – Safety – Part 2-24: Particular requirements for refrigerating appliances, ice-cream appliances and ice-makers**


According to procedures for development of Zanzibar Standards the draft standards are hereby circulated for stakeholder's comments.

We kindly request you to go through the draft standards and send your comments regarding its technical contents. Suggestion which entails revision of text should indicate the preferred wording and the relevant clause should be quoted against each comment.
