Scope

This East African standard covers the energy efficiency and functional performance requirements, sampling and test methods for general service lamps and tubular lamps.

NOTE For detail on which general service lamps and tubular lamps are included and excluded, see clause 5.

1.2 This standard does not apply to high-intensity discharge lamps.

1.3 This standard does not cover safety requirements of lighting products.
