## Lighting products — Minimum energy performance standard — Part 2: Luminaires

### Scope

1.1 This East African standard covers the energy efficiency and functional performance requirements, sampling and test methods for luminaires namely indoor ambient luminaires and outdoor / streetlight luminaires.

NOTE For details on luminaires that are included and excluded, see clause 5.

1.2 This standard does not apply to indoor ambient luminaires or outdoor/streetlight luminaires specifically tested and approved to operate:

- a) in potentially explosive atmospheres;
- b) for emergency use; and
- c) in or on aircraft.

1.3 This standard does not cover safety requirements for luminaires.
